
SUBJECT: Asbestos Management Plan for Martin County Schools
2010-2011 Academic School Year

This notice is sent to assure you that Martin County Schools is in compliance with both national and state regulations and laws related to building materials which contain asbestos that have been used in building construction in past years.

An inspection for building materials which contain asbestos has been completed for all school buildings owned, leased, or otherwise occupied by Martin County Schools. This inspection has been conducted by a certified inspector, and the material samples were evaluated by an accredited laboratory. Building materials containing as little as two percent (2%) asbestos or assumed positive have been identified and made a part of an Asbestos Management Plan for the school system.

A complete Asbestos Management Plan for the school is available at the Principal's office during regular business hours.

We will continue to notify you at least once each year on the status of the Asbestos Management Plan. Additional notification may be issued as a result of an additional inspection, normal surveillance practices, response actions or remodeling work which might disturb building materials which contains asbestos. Every precaution will continue to be utilized in order to protect the well being of students and employees of the Martin County Schools.
